Teach voice lessons, elementary music theory, and aural skills to students age 7 through adult. Each lesson is tailored for the student's level of theory, aural training, and vocal development. For students 6-11, I teach Kodály methodology and often musical theater. For students 12-18, I use a mixture of theory and aural skills training resources. We select and prepare folk, art song, musical theater and even songs featured in anime. Repertoire is greatly influenced by the student's needs and/or interests. Adult students primarily focus on singing technique as it applies to their repertoire.

Teach piano lessons and elementary music theory to students ages 4-16. Each lesson is tailored for beginning to intermediate student's level of theory, aural training, and development. For early students ages 5-6, I teach Kodály methodology combined with Faber Piano Adventures First Piano method books. For students 7+, I use the Faber Piano Adventures Primer Level or Level 3B books for theory, lessons, technique, and performance based on their previous understanding of music theory concepts. Extra performance repertoire is greatly influenced by the student's needs and/or interests.

Teach voice lessons, elementary music theory, and aural skills to students age 7 through adult. Each lesson is tailored for the student's level of theory, aural training, and vocal development. We select and prepare folk, art song, musical theater and even songs featured in anime. Repertoire is greatly influenced by the student's needs and/or interests.
